

This Gemini New Moon is a Solar eclipse and Mercury will soon reach inferior conjunction. With Mercury in its own sign, we can expect communication to carry extra weight. Retrograde Mercury is squaring nebulous Neptune which is in its home sign too, creating extra uncertainty and confusion. Neptunian smoke screens make it difficult to understand what's going on. The truth may be hard to discern, especially when any new information comes to light and needs to be assimilated.



Saturn and Uranus cross paths on the 15th with the 2nd hit of their fixed square this year. This one is



pivotal with a number of pending decisions likely to be time critical. Note that this aspect will continue to be in play until at least October 2022 when it is almost exact again.



## Charts in the News Scott Morrison (Rating X)




Scott Morrison, or as I like to call him, Sir Scott Moron (anagram) recently had a birthday. Without a known time of birth there are still a few notable transits we can examine. I've used 12 noon for this chart.

T Uranus is on his Venus and T Saturn squares his Venus and these transits will remain in orb until at least November, shaking up his values and creating a fair degree of stress. He's trying very hard to stick to his narrative and his old school values, but this is a losing battle. Fixed signs do not easily change their views so he will probably continue to struggle to adapt.

Morrison is a slippery customer with his natal Neptune opposite his Sun and the Moon is somewhere near nebulous Neptune too, either in Scorpio or Sagittarius. Politicians often have a strong Neptune, which is probably why we can't trust most of them.

# capricorn Full Moon



Saturn and Uranus continue to test us, with their square aspect still very close. Some of the challenges we see with this aspect are questions about whether to persist with a task or stressful situation or throw caution to the wind and break free. Fear and how we manage it is often a key factor with this aspect. This fixed square also asks us whether we should follow the established secure path, or opt for an uncertain road less travelled that offers us more freedom and the possibility of a better future. There is no right or wrong response.


Moon may seem more subdued and quieter than most, at least on the surface. But at the same time there is a lot of underwater peddling going on to keep our equilibrium.

Jupiter trines the Sun and sextiles the Moon, providing a pleasant comfortable feeling, and yet Jupiter stations can lead us into risky ventures if we over-estimate our capabilities. All in all this is a fairly

stressful Full Moon. The workload will probably be high and there could be family issues to attend to as well. Mars opposes Saturn which in itself is a frustrating aspect so try to focus on one thing at a time.


Try to ensure you get plenty of rest and relaxation to restore your energy and your mental and emotional wellbeing.



# solstice

The Solstice has quickly come around once again, heralding the start of the winter in the southern hemisphere and summer in the north.



This solstice sees the Moon, the natural ruler of Cancer, in another water



