

scorpio new Moon

Uranus is really shaking things up. Last month I spoke about the impact that the current Uranus transit is having for Australia and for Scott Morrison. 12 degrees of Taurus features in both charts. The latest political casualty is NSW Premier Gladys Berejiklian who resigned early last month. I had thought she might resign this year, due to stress, or health issues, given she is having her Chiron Return and has been under a lot of pressure, so I talked about that in my September INsight. As it turns out, that was not that reason she resigned, but resign she did. Her Venus is 12 Scorpio.

This is an invisible Supermoon. The Sun and Moon (12SC40) are exactly opposite Uranus (12TA47). Change is propelling us forward whether we like it or not. Those who struggle to cope with change



will feel this Uranus transit the most. One of them is PM Scott Morrison.

We're in the midst of a big political shake-up. While the Libs and the Nationals are kicking and screaming, the states and businesses have made their own commitments to emission targets. This Supermoon will happen when the Glasgow Climate Conference is underway.

The planet Uranus is different from all others in our solar system.

It's angle of rotation is tilted at 98 degrees and its magnetic poles are 60 degrees away from that angle. This creates a giant corkscrew magnetic field that stretches millions of kilometres across space.

Uranus in Taurus is urging us to change our wasteful ways and **address climate change.** We're about half way through this seven-year transit. At this New Moon, Uranus is making its closest approach to the Earth, and so is the Moon.

This is a big wake-up call.



Charts in the News Dominic Perrottet-Noon Chart



Like Gladys Berejiklian, the new NSW Premier, Dominic Perrottet is a Virgo. In fact he was born 12 years (minus one day) after her.

That means their Sun and Jupiter positions are virtually identical.

The new Premier is far more to the political right than Gladys, and he is a staunch Catholic.

His chart features a tight Mars-Uranus-Ceres conjunction, which is a bit of a wild aspect, but he also has Mercury conjunct Saturn and Pluto which is far more conservative.

There are some radical right wing elements at play here, perhaps cloaked behind a conservative façade.

We don't know his time of birth so the Moon at 12 Scorpio is not confirmed, but it's suggestive given the current cluster of sudden political events with transiting Uranus at 12 Taurus.

This Full Moon is a partial lunar eclipse. Most of the eclipse will be visible in Australia. It starts around Moonrise.

Although it's classified as a partial eclipse, the vast majority of the

Moon will enter the Earth's shadow, so it will look like a total eclipse except for a slither of silvery Moon.

Once again Uranus is in focus. Mars is now opposing Uranus, so **the unsettled energy that's been prevalent over recent weeks and months is set to continue.**

At this Full Moon, Venus forms a trine with Uranus and sextiles Mars, facilitating a path through some of the recent heated debates.

Venus has a gift for diplomacy and the ability to effectively manage relationships.


The Nodal Axis is about to shift from mutable signs into fixed signs, which will push those sitting on the fence onto one side or the other.

Venus and Mars, rulers of Taurus and Scorpio, are in a harmonious sextile aspect, so there is an oppor-

tunity to reach workable compromises, once minds are made up.


As we head towards the end of the year we have yet more powerful aspects to come that involve Uranus. One of them I discuss this month on page 6.



Saturn square Uranus

This year we have seen the tense interplay of the Saturn-Uranus fixed square. The third hit of this transit **happens on Christmas Eve, but it's not over. In 2022** we may get some respite from the immediate impacts of this challenging square, but in October next year **it's almost exact once again. Orbs for aspects, especially those involving slow moving planets, always stretch out beyond their exact alignments.**

For most of this year we have seen a tense stand-off between these two disparate entities. Fixed squares can result in stalemates.

It's important to adhere to Saturn's rules and also to have freedom. But when either archetype is disowned and projected onto others, tension can erupt.

It's been my experience that Uranus is only chaotic and disruptive when Saturn has not been fully mastered. When that happens, radical elements can potentially take hold of established systems. The best way to use this square is to implement long overdue changes where current systems (Saturn) are no longer viable for the future (Uranus).

This aspect has generated tension and conflict between those who want to see progress and change, and those who prefer the security of the past. Likewise, those who want freedom and those who take a more cautious approach are also at odds. These groups are not mutually exclusive. As we

emerge from lockdown and open up post COVID, this debate will shift to different settings. Chief among these is likely to be climate change.

Those who are progressive thinkers and are also self-disciplined and responsible have mastered the lessons of Saturn and are keen to embrace the Uranus archetype. But those who have not yet fully engaged with Saturn, under the pressure of this stressful aspect,

are more likely to become radical and reckless, protesting their right to personal freedom. They fear authority figures (Saturn) and see rules as impeding their freedom and human rights (Uranus).



Similarly, those who cling to the past and assert their right to freedom have neither security, nor freedom. They fear the change (Uranus).

But for all of us, fixed squares are arguably the **toughest aspects to work through. There's a lot of tension and stress in this aspect.**

There will be further challenges to face in 2022 as Saturn (old school policies) and Uranus (future innovations) attempt to resolve their differences. To release stress, something must change. But fear of the future and fear of change can halt progress. Government policies need to change in many areas to address climate change.

It will be interesting to see how this battle continues to unfold throughout 2022.
